

Notice To Receive 943 Notes

Purpose:

The Notice To Receive (NTR) is sent out from General Mills. It contains info for the trading partner on what they will be expecting from shipping site for interplant transfers directed to them. This transaction is sent as an event driven activity (at the time the shipment is created) so they can plan what is coming into them. This is *prior* to the Advance Ship Notice (EDI=856) which gets created when the shipment is successfully processed by the sending location. Partners may use the 943 to create the inbound order and then use the 856 to change the inbound order.

Timing:

Note the W0612 element to determine if this is the original transaction. This will be generated when the shipment transaction is created in our SAP system (carrier accepts the load and transportation job runs). We will also send changes and deletes as they happen.

Setup:

This transaction uses the X12 EDI standards (not UCS like other warehousing documents from General Mills). It is version 4010.

Integration into your system / Possible test scenarios:

Basic test for connectivity and setup

Multiple material codes on the delivery.

Complete set = New 943 / change 943 / 856. You would then send us a 944.

Delete set = A new 943 / Delete 943.
